DESCRIPTION

Mapefast Super Set Plus (formerly known as Polychem Super Set Plus) is a non-chloride, water-reducing admixture formulated to accelerate the strength development and setting time of concrete in cold weather. Mapefast Super Set Plus can reduce labor costs associated with the finishing process. Because the non-corrosive Mapefast Super Set Plus will not aid in the corrosion of reinforcing steel embedded within the concrete, it is recommended for use in all types of concrete, especially reinforced and prestressed.

WHERE TO USE

Mapefast Super Set Plus is recommended for use in all types of concrete, especially reinforced and prestressed.

In plastic concrete, Mapefast Super Set Plus:

- Accelerates setting times.
- Ensures superior and earlier finishing of slabs (flatwork) and can reduce labor costs associated with the finishing process.
- Reduces heating costs and protection time related to curing in cold weather.
- Reduces segregation and bleeding.

In hardened concrete, Mapefast Super Set Plus:

- Increases early-age strengths.
- Ensures superior finished appearance.
- Ensures early stripping and reuse of formworks.
- Reduces cracking.

MIXING

Mapefast Super Set Plus can be added at the concrete plant or on the jobsite. When it is used with other admixtures, dispense each admixture separately into the mix. If Mapefast Super Set Plus is added after the initial mixing sequence, concrete should be mixed for an additional 5 minutes to ensure proper mixing.

COMPATIBILITY WITH OTHER PRODUCTS

Mapefast Super Set Plus is compatible with most products for preparing quality concrete. It is especially compatible with:

- Standard air-entraining admixtures.
- Viscosity-modifying admixtures.
- Approved MAPEI form-release agents for releasing concrete from formworks.
- Expansive agents and shrinkage-compensating admixtures to produce shrinkage-resistant concrete.
- Curing compounds from the *Mapecure* product family to protect against rapid water evaporation.
- Silica-fume-based powder additions.
- Class C and Class F fly ash.
- Ground-granulated blast-furnace slag (GGBFS).
- Various types of limestone fillers for manufacturing self-consolidating concrete and any other type of concrete that requires these fillers.
- All types of Portland cements.

DOSAGE RATES

Use 8 to 32 U.S. oz. per 100 lbs. (520 to 2 080 mL per 100 kg) of cementitious material, depending upon the acceleration needed/required, the ambient temperature and the concrete temperature. Dosage rates outside of the suggested range should be tested before using in production. Contact MAPEI's Technical Services Department for assistance.

PACKAGING

Mapefast Super Set Plus is available by bulk delivery, in 55 U.S. gal. (208 L) drums and in 275 U.S. gal. (1041 L) totes.

STORAGE

The typical freezing point of *Mapefast Super Set Plus* is 5°F (-15°C). *Mapefast Super Set Plus* should be protected against freezing. In the event that freezing does occur, thaw and mildly agitate the product to restore original consistency. Air pressure is not recommended.
